

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# CODE OF RULES, REGULATIONS AND GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS

2018

#### PREAMBLE:

Lugari Diploma Teachers Training College is a Public Institution which was established by the District Education Board (DEB) in 2010 but had its first intake in September 2015

All students enrolled at Lugari Diploma Teachers Training College are expected to follow all rules and regulations meant to govern the behavior and conduct of students as members of the College Community. These rules, regulations and guidelines are anchored on the Constitution of Kenya and are formulated based on sound ethics and religious principles and are founded on the premise that people must treat others with dignity and respect in order for scholarship to thrive.

Any violations of this regulations may lead to disciplinary action being taken against the student.

Indicated below are a summary of the rules, regulations and guidelines. Upon admission the student shall indicate acceptance by signing.

## 1. **COURTESY**

(A).

- i) All students should be courteous to teaching staff, non-teaching staff, student leaders and visitors at all times.
- ii) Staff quarters, Staffrooms and Offices are out of bounds to all students unless with permission from relevant authority.
- iii) Students are expected to use the official languages of Kenya, English or Kiswahili at all gatherings.
- iv) No visitors should be seen during class time. In the event of emergency visits, clearance shall be granted by the Dean of Students' office. All visitors should leave the compound before 6:00p.m
- v) No visitors are allowed in the halls of residence/boarding area or classrooms
- (B) Contravention of the above will lead to any or all of the following disciplinary measure by:
  - a) Appear before the SRC disciplinary Committee
  - b) Appear before the Office of the Dean
  - c) Appear before the **Discipline Committee**
  - d) Written warning letter from the Chief Principal
  - e) Board of Management (BOM) Suspension for one academic year or discontinuation.

## 2. **DISCIPLINE**

Students are expected to observe integrity. Indiscipline includes but is not limited to the following areas;-

- i) Alcohol/drug and substance abuse
- ii) Mass indiscipline
- iii) Immorality
- iv) Fighting
- v) Theft
- vi) Sneaking
- vii) Defiance/disrespect to authority/incitement
- viii) Prohibited literature
- ix) Use of mobile phones and radio during class time.
- x) Open love relationships
- xi) Fraud/forgery
- xii) Exam irregularities or malpractices

Failure to adhere to the above will lead to any or all of the of the following:-

- a) Appear before the disciplinary committee who may recommend suspension of upto 12 days
- b) Repeated contravention of the above may lead to appearing before BOM who may recommend either suspension for one academic year or discontinuation.
- c) Criminal charges by the state agencies depending on the gravity of the matter.

## 3. COLLEGE PROGRAMMES

- i) All College programmes are compulsory whether out or within the College.
- ii) Punctuality should be observed in all these programmes.
- iii) Assemblies, flag raising assembly on Monday and Friday and other public functions within the College are compulsory and should be respected.
- iv) All Lectures are compulsory
- v) Students are expected to take part in co-curricular activities that include games and sports, clubs and societies and other relevant



#### PREAMBLE:

Lugari Diploma Teachers Training College is a Public Institution which was established by the District Education Board (DEB) in 2010 but had its first intake in September 2015

All students enrolled at Lugari Diploma Teachers Training College are expected to follow all rules and regulations meant to govern the behavior and conduct of students as members of the College Community. These rules, regulations and guidelines are anchored on the Constitution of Kenya and are formulated based on sound ethics and religious principles and are founded on the premise that people must treat others with dignity and respect in order for scholarship to thrive.

Any violations of this regulations may lead to disciplinary action being taken against the student.

Indicated below are a summary of the rules, regulations and guidelines. Upon admission the student shall indicate acceptance by signing.

## 1. COURTESY

(A).

- i) All students should be courteous to teaching staff, non-teaching staff, student leaders and visitors at all times.
- ii) Staff quarters, Staffrooms and Offices are out of bounds to all students unless with permission from relevant authority.
- iii) Students are expected to use the official languages of Kenya, English or Kiswahili at all gatherings.
- iv) No visitors should be seen during class time. In the event of emergency visits, clearance shall be granted by the Dean of Students' office. All visitors should leave the compound before 6:00p.m
- v) No visitors are allowed in the halls of residence/boarding area or classrooms
- (B) Contravention of the above will lead to any or all of the following disciplinary measure by:
  - a) Appear before the SRC disciplinary Committee
  - b) Appear before the Office of the Dean
  - c) Appear before the Discipline Committee
  - d) Written warning letter from the Chief Principal
  - e) Board of Management (BOM) Suspension for one academic year or discontinuation.

## 2. **DISCIPLINE**

Students are expected to observe integrity. Indiscipline includes but is not limited to the following areas;-

Failure to adhere to the above will lead to any or all of the of the following:-

- a) Appear before the disciplinary committee who may recommend suspension of upto 12 days
- b) Repeated contravention of the above may lead to appearing before BOM who may recommend either suspension for one academic year or discontinuation.
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## 3. COLLEGE PROGRAMMES

- i) All College programmes are compulsory whether out or within the College.
- ii) Punctuality should be observed in all these programmes.
- iii) Assemblies, flag raising assembly on Monday and Friday and other public functions within the College are compulsory and should be respected.
- iv) All Lectures are compulsory
- v) Students are expected to take part in co-curricular activities that include games and sports, clubs and societies and other relevant



social activities e.g. drama, music, cultural festivals e.t.c.

vi) Students are also encouraged to attend various religious services of their faith as arranged by the College.

## Contravention will lead to any or all of the following:

- a) Appear before the Disciplinary committee who may recommend suspension for upto 12 days
- b) Written warning from the Chief Principal
- c) BOM suspension for one academic year or discontinuation from the course.

## 4. COLLEGE PROPERTY

- i) College facilities and equipment must be properly used; malicious damage and loss will result in: 1. surcharging accordingly. 2. criminal proceeding against individual.
- ii) Only authorized and approved materials and work may be displayed on College Notice Boards.

## Contravention of the above will lead to any or all of the following:-

- a) Appear before the disciplinary committee who may recommend suspension of upto 12 days.
- b) Surcharging
- c) Criminal proceeding against individual
- d) BOM suspension for one academic year or discontinuation from the course.

## 5. <u>ABSENCE FROM COLLEGE</u>

- i) A student who absents himself/herself from College for seven consecutive days or a total of fifteen days in a term or is absent for a total of twenty one days in a year is considered to have withdrawn from the College.
- ii) A student may be granted leave of absence from the College in the following ways:
  - a) Short leave: A student will be authorised by Dean of Students' office to travel and be back on the same day before 6:00p.m
  - b) Long leave: A student will be authorized by Dean of Students, Deputy Principal or Principal to be away from College overnight.

Contravention will lead to any or all of the following

- a) Appear before the disciplinary committee who may recommend suspension of upto 12 days.
- b) Warning letter from the Chief Principal
- c) Suspension for one academic year or discontinuation from course by BOM.

## 6. PERSONAL/COLLEGE CLEANLINESS.

- i) All students should be well groomed/smart at all times.
- ii) All students should keep the hostels, lecture halls, dining hall and the general College environment clean and tidy.
- iii) All students are expected to dress **decently** at all times as stipulated in TSC code on dress code
- iv) Any Lecturer will demand students to dress appropriately as stipulated in the article below:-

## 20/2012 TSC ACT SUBSISDIARY LEGISLATION Regulation No 12: Professionalism

- ◆ A teacher shall maintain a neat and decent standard of dressing which befits the dignity and image of the teaching service
- ◆ Ensure his/her appearance and personal hygiene is not offensive to workmates or those they serve

## Contravention will lead to:-

- a) Appear before the disciplinary committee who may recommend suspension of upto 12 days
- b) Warning letter from the Chief Principal
- c) Suspension for one academic year or discontinuation from the course by BOM.

## 7. ILLNESS

- i) Sick students should report to the College clinical officer/Nurse immediately and not rest in the hostels.
- ii) Students who require specialized treatment or students with

- contagious and communicable diseases will be referred back home for further management.
- iii) Any medical referral cost out of College clinic will be met by the parent or guardian.

## 8. CATERING SERVICES

- i) Kitchen and stores are out of bounds to students.
- ii) All meals shall be served and eaten in the Dining Hall.
- iii) Meal cards MUST be produced in order to be served.
- iv) All students **must queue** to be served.
- v) No special diet will be provided.
- vi) Punctuality and etiquette (good table manners) should be observed during meal times.

## Contravention may lead to any or all of the following:-

- a) Appear before the disciplinary committee who may recommend suspension of upto 12 days
- b) Warning letter from the Chief Principal
- c) Suspension for one academic year or discontinuation from the course by BOM.

- Criminal charges by the relevant authority depending on the C) seriousness of the case.
- d) BOM suspension for one academic year or discontinuation from the course.

#### 13. WITHDRAWAL FROM TRAINING

Students once admitted are expected to pursue the three years' course without interruption of whatever nature. However, a student shall seek to withdraw or defer from training on the following grounds:

- i) Maternity leave
- ii) Financial incapability
- iii) Medical reasons
- iv) Further education elsewhere.
- v) Students should ensure they have properly filled the relevant documents before departure. Contravention may be assumed self withdrawal.

NB: Readmission will entail:

a) Fill readmission forms from Dean's office on a working day.

b) Follow due process of readmission

c) Incase of discipline leave, report to the Deputy Principal TALC.

d) ALL the above cases to undergo guidance and counseling services on readmission.

## OTHER SERVICES OFFERED BY THE COLLEGE

## 1. Guidance and counselling

- a. Students who require guidance and counselling services should feel free to visit the Dean of students' office for necessary assistance. Confidentiality in all cases will be highly observed.
- b. Guidance and counselling services are skewed towards academic responsibility/issues and therefore students are advised to liaise with the Registrar.
- c. As part of training, students are expected to take up leadership roles and execute their responsibilities in the students' council. However, students are cautioned against engaging in decisive political activities/ideologies but instead embrace national integration.
- 2. While in the halls of residence students would do well to avoid generating noise from such gadgets as radios, mobiles, laptops etc. especially after 2300 hours.
- 3. Any student **correspondence** verbal or written sent out by or addressed to students groups' or individual having bearing on such groups activities must be channeled through/or observe protocol. (No student may write any correspondence on behalf of the Principal or any other college official).

4. College transport facilities.

Clubs and societies and other students must forward their request to the principal

through the Dean of students and the patron of the club or society or group. Any student, club or society or group using College transport facilities must be accompanied by their patron or an authorized lecturer or College official who takes full charge of the group, or trip or the itinerary.

#### 5. Clubs and societies

- a. Students shall be expected to join a club and society of their choice.
- b. The clubs and societies shall not be based on tribal or ethnic inclinations but champion students interests and as much as possible foster national integration.
- c. The clubs and societies shall not be used to solicit for funds from students or the public and if so, should be with the consent of the Principal.
- d. Clubs and societies shall have fully registered and recognized elected officials and members, and should operate under guidance of a patron.
- e. All invitations for guest speakers or visitors by clubs shall be channeled through the office of the Principal.

#### 6. Welfare Guidelines

- a. In the event of the passing on of a student, the College contribution shall be Ksh 7,000/- (Kshs seven thousand only) given to the documented parent/guardian. Facilitation of transport for three welfare officials depending on the locality shall be provided.
- b. In the event of the passing on of (i) child (ii) spouse (iii) parent/documented guardian, the College shall give from the Welfare Kitty Ksh 5,000/- (Kshs five thousand only) given to the student.
